



Genetic Testing Form

To our patients at Great Neck Obstetrics & Gynecology:

At your first prenatal visit we will be doing a series of blood tests to see if you are a carrier for genetic disorders that may affect your baby.

Regarding Insurance Coverage: This testing is subject to copay, deductible or co-insurance based on your individual policy. In addition, some insurance policies may not cover the tests. Because these tests are costly (several hundred dollars), we advise you to check with your insurance company prior to having the blood tests drawn.

Below is a list of the disorders you will be screened for along with a CPT code to give your insurance company when you are checking for coverage:

- Cystic Fibrosis
- Dihydrolipomide Dehydrogenase Deficiency

- Hemoglobinopathy (including beta thalassemia and sickle cell)
- Joubert Syndrome 2
- Maple Syrup Urine Disease Type 1A/1B
- Mucopolipidosis Type IV
- Nemaline Myopathy
- Niemann-Pick Disease Type A/B
- Spinal Muscular Atrophy
- Tay Sachs Enzyme/DNA
- Usher Syndrome 1F/111
- Walker Warburg Syndrome
